Abstract

Formatted in Times New Roman (TNR) 10, italic, justified alignment, single spacing, with an indent at the beginning of each paragraph. The abstract should provide sufficient information to allow readers to understand the nature and significance of the subject. It should highlight the article's objectives, research methods, data collection and processing, and key results. To enhance the article's visibility, the abstract should reiterate key words and phrases relevant to the topic while avoiding unnecessary repetition (maximum 250 characters).

Keywords: Indicate 4-7 key terms (words or phrases) in descending order of relevance that capture the essence of the paper. Ensure alignment with the title and abstract of the article (TNR 10, italic).

Main Text

The main body of the paper should be formatted in TNR 12, justified alignment, 1.5 line spacing, with an indent at the start of each paragraph. Introduction and conclusions are not numbered, while other subsections should be numbered (4-12 pages).

Footnotes: First name and last name of the author, title of the work (italicized), publisher, location, year of publication, page/pages (TNR 10).

For articles: First name, last name, article title, volume (italicized), issue, year of publication, page/pages (p/pp).

Use an author-number citation style.

Bibliography

Sources cited in the text should appear in the reference list:

- Last name, first name, title of the work (italicized), publisher, location, year of publication, page/pages (TNR 12).

- For articles: First name, last name, article title, volume (italicized), issue, year of publication, page/pages (p/pp).
